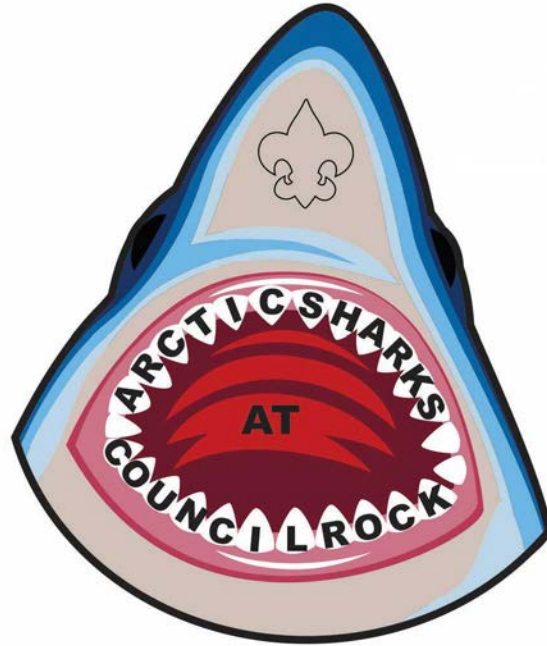
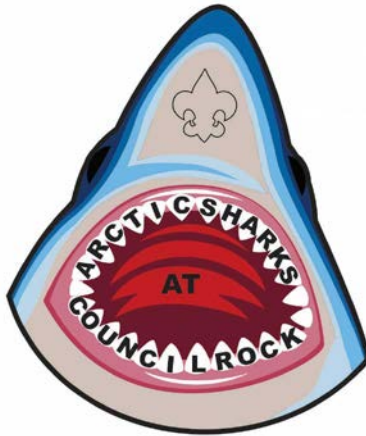

Early Bird PAYMENT DUE August 3, 2017 by 5 pm

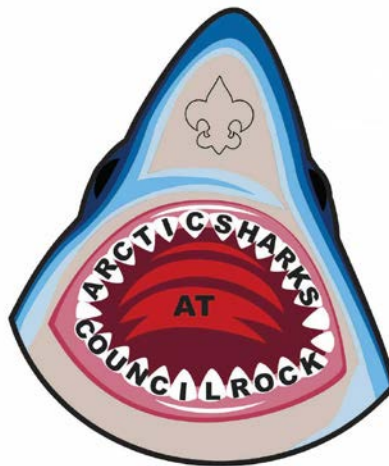
ALL FINAL Payments are Due August 31, 2017

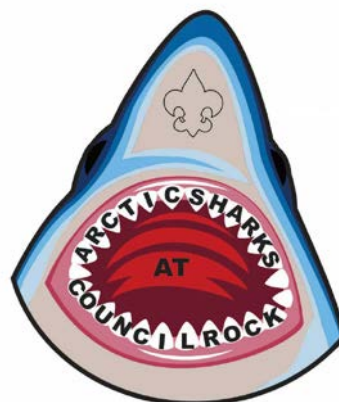
- 1. Flags – Honor Lodge**
